The College of Agriculture and Natural Resources (CANRE) was fully registered by the National Council of Technical Education (NACTE) in June 2012 with registration number **REG**/**ANE/024**with **Full Accreditation** Status to provide technical training in the field of agriculture, natural resources and environment.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- You are required to observe all entry requirements as stipulated in the document titled "Students Information Leading to Award of Ordinary Diploma in General Agriculture/ Animal Health and Production" which you need to read and understand before applying for the course.
- 2. The College of Agricultural and Natural Resources (CANRE) is expected to open on 01thMarch 2021. Students will be received between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00p.m. The first week is for orientation activities.All 1st year students are required to participate in the orientation week programme. More information will be given on arrival. The registration deadline for first year students will be TWO WEEKS from the first date of Orientation Week.

3. An academic year has two semesters, each lasts for 15 weeks. A semester may briefly extend for a few days to compensate for non-training events such as public holidays, end of the year examinations, marking and compilation. Short vacations shall occur between semesters and a long annual recess at the end of the academic year.

TUITION FEES AND OTHER FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS:

There are two types of fees payable at the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources such as (a) Direct College Costs and (b) student's direct costs) as follows:

a) Direct College Costs

Total Costs paid to the College is **Tshs. 2,310,000**/= being tuition fees is **Tshs.1,100,000**/= per academic year which caters for Theories, On Station Practical Training and Examinations. Other financial requirements (**Tshs. 1,210,000**/=) are as shown in the table below.

b) Direct Student's Costs

Note: Sponsors are required to support the student (s) during this period, by paying to the student (s) at least the amount as the college directives from time to time. The duration of field attachment is Thirty (30) days for first year and Sixty (60) days for second year.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Academic year has two semesters which lasts for 210 days
- 2. Fees once paid are NOT refundable
- 3. Direct college fees are to be fully or partly (two installment) paid at the commencement of the academic year (In semester basis)
- 4. Fees does not include allowances such as transport and incidental expenses
- 5. The college deserves the right to change the rate of fees at any time during the year as deem fit
- 6. Students are expected to pay for incidental expenses for such things such as toilet soaps, toothpastes, laundry expenses and pocket money. Parents/Sponsors are required to support students to meet these expenses.
- 7. Any private payment to the students through the College Account shall be charged 2% as bank charges

Note: Cash payment will not be accepted and money for private use or incidental expenses should never ever be deposited into the college bank account.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

The College provides for a room, bed and mattress, additional to the above students are required to bring the followings:
